

Number Facts

A priority is the development of **fluent basic mathematics facts recall** (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) to enable our students to develop and engage with higher order mathematics concepts and skills. Literacy Pro is an online reading program designed to increase independent reading and improve comprehension through quizzes and tests. The program allows students to manage their own Independent Reading by choosing books of interest and according to their ability. It develops reading stamina in all students and through the use of rewards and prizes increases student engagement in reading.
