## FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS STATE SCHOOL

PREP

Prep students at FVHS are involved in a variety of learning activities to improve oral language, gross motor skills (eg climbing, skipping, ball skills) and fine motor skills (eg threading, cutting, painting). The children engage in play experiences which focus on high levels of problem solving and communication skills.

Prep students attend a specialist Music and Physical Education Lesson once a week. Our Prep students learn computer skills and are engaged in Digital Technology learning experiences. They borrow from the school library.

The Casey Caterpillar Program has been adopted at Fairview Heights as our way of teaching Handwriting. It is a



program that uses a story about a caterpillar called Casey and her adventures on the branch of a tree. It is a process through which students, from the time they begin to write, are taught to form letters correctly using simple shapes drawn from the illustrated story. Through this process, students will not simply make the letters look correct, but learn to make the strokes of letters correctly and in the correct order. Features of the program include:

- Aural: consistent, familiar language is used to describe letter-stroke shapes eg. The Caterpillar's wide open mouth and the possum tail.
- Visual: visual cues are used to enhance visual perception of shape and differences in shape of letter strokes.
- Oral: use of verbalisation of letter strokes using consistent familiar language.
- Kinaesthetic: the bringing to automaticity of the writing of letter strokes and letters whilst verbalising the sequence of formation.
- Letter strokes: these are taught and mastered before letters are introduced

## The program is introduced and mastered in the Prep year and revised and consolidated in Year 1.

Jolly Phonics - Jolly Phonics uses actions to teach each of the 42 letter sounds.

Magic 100 Sight Words - Prep students learn sight words to improve their ability to read and write. Designed and developed by Marcella Reiter, an experienced Classroom Teacher, Education Consultant and Psychologist, the Magic 100 Words (1-100 words), Magic 200 Words (101-200 words) and Magic 300 Words (201-300 words) make up an average of 70% of the words used in reading and writing. Learning the most frequently used words rapidly improves reading, increases fluency and develops comprehension.
